

CAREER GUIDANCE & JOB SEARCH

Volunteer Career Advisors Initiative

• Provides workers with peer-level support and sectoral/occupational- specific career guidance

Eligibility:

All Singaporeans and Permanent Residents

Polaris

- Personalized career coaching support from certified career coaches.
- Tailored Career Development Plan based on individual strengths, values, and aspirations.

Eligibility:

• All Employed Singaporeans and Permanent Residents

MyCareersFuture

- A fast and smart job search service to match jobseekers with relevant jobs, based on skills and competencies
- Ability to filter jobs eligible for Government support and access resource
- articles on career related tips, human capital development and industry insights

Career Centres

- WSG's Careers Connect, NTUC's e2i Centres and WSG's Careers Connect On-the-Go (CCOTG)
- One-stop centre for career-related advice and assistance
- A team to guide jobseekers depending on level of preparedness Featuring workshops and resources to hone jobsearch skills

Eligibility:


- Unemployed and eligible jobseekers* who have been actively searching for jobs OR

JOBS & ATTACHMENTS

Career Conversion Programme (CCP)

- Helps mid-career PMETs reskill through structured and on-the-job training to take on new roles/jobs
- Duration: 3 to 24 months, based on job requirement More than 100 PCPs across 30 sectors

Eligibility:

- · Min. 21 years old*, graduated/completed NS for at least 2 years
- New job role trained for under the CCP should be substantially different from previous job role(s)

Mid-Career Pathways Programme

- Widen your professional network and gain meaningful industryrelevant skills and experience
- Receive training allowance of up to \$3,800 per month
- Conversion to full-time employment if performance is deemed satisfactory

Eligibility:

Mid-career individuals* aged 40 and above

Employment Support for Seniors

 Career advisory services to help seniors identify career options Career advisory services for Seniors to establish job readiness Job matching services for Seniors

Eligibility:

- Aged 50 years and above*; and
- · Unemployed and seeking to enter or re-enter the workforce

Employment Support for Persons with Disabilities (PWDs)*

- Career advisory to establish job readiness, and identify training and career options
- Course fee subsidies of up to 95% for SG Enable's list of curated training courses
- Training allowance of \$6.00 per hour
- Training commitment award of \$100.00 per completed course

Overseas Markets Immersion Programme (OMIP)

- OMIP is a WSG initiative that supports companies in reskilling both new and existing employees
- Gain invaluable work experience abroad and develop in-demand skills for a global or regional role.
- Receive up to 70% support for your salary and overseas allowance.

TRAINING & UPSKILLING

SkillsFuture Career Transition Programme (SCTP)

- Supports mid-career individuals in acquiring industry-relevant skills to improve employability and pivot to new sectors/job roles
- Part-time or full-time modular training courses Duration: 3 to 12 months
- · Nett course fee can be offset by SkillsFuture Credit

Eligibility:

 Individuals* looking for training opportunities to transit to a new sector/job role

MySkillsFuture

 One-stop portal for individuals* to access learning pathways and list of training programmes to broaden and deepen skills

Skills Framework

 Provide key information on sector, career pathways, occupations/job roles, existing and emerging skills, training programmes for skills upgrading and mastery

SkillsFuture Level-Up Programme

- Provide greater structural support for mid-career Singaporeans aged 40 years and above to pursue a substantive skills reboot and stay relevant in a changing economy
- SkillsFuture Credit (Mid-Career) top-up of \$4,000, to further offset outof- pocket course fees for selected courses
- Additionally, from Academic Year 2025, Singaporeans can receive subsidies for another publicly-funded full-time diploma, and qualify for the Mid-Career Enhanced Subsidy (MCES)

Jobs Transformation Maps

- Provide detailed insights on the impact of technology and automation on the industry and workforce to support employers in their job transformation efforts
- Identify the key technologies that are driving change, the impact on individual job roles, the pathways for employers to transform jobs and for workers to acquire requisite skills as existing job roles evolve

SkillsFuture Mid-Career Enhanced Subsidy

 Provides additional subsidies to encourage individuals to upskill and reskill to adapt to changing job requirements.

Eligibility:

Singapore Citizens aged 40 and above

SUPPORT SCHEMES

SkillsFuture Jobseeker Support scheme

- Provides temporary financial support of up to \$6,000 for 6 months for involuntarily unemployed individuals*
- Support these individuals in finding a job that makes better use of their skills and experiences

WSG's Career Events

SkillsFuture Credit

- Encourages Singaporeans to take ownership of their skills development and lifelong learning
- Since 2015, all Singaporeans aged 25 and above will receive an opening credit of S\$500
- In 2020, a one-off top-up of \$500 has been provided to every Singaporean aged 25 years and above
- In addition to the above, a further one-off top-up of \$500 was provided to every Singaporean aged 40 to 60 (inclusive)
- These <u>additional top-ups</u> can be used on all SkillsFuture Credit-eligible courses, and <u>will expire on 31 Dec 2025</u>

Skills and Training Advisory Services

 Guide individuals* to identify skills and training needs to support growth at different stages of career, and receive recommendation on suitable courses and programmes
